Greetings,

We are just a few weeks from opening day, Saturday, May 28th. We have quite a bit of work to get done in the next few weeks but expect to have the pool open on time. I would like to thank everyone for their efforts in getting the pool ready. Some repairs to the bottom of the pool are now being done in addition to repairs to the baby pool. Kevin Reagan assures me that he has it all under control. (How do you like the size of that bus?)

At this time I would like to ask pool members if they know of a person or company that has experience with asphalt. As many of you have noticed over the last few years our parking lot is starting to deteriorate and we are in need of some professional advice on how best to proceed with improvements.

This leads me to my next item, over the next few months the pool board will put together a short term and long term plan on how to best address some major issues regarding pool maintenance and repairs to the pool facilities that we will soon be facing as our 40 year old pool "ages".

Lastly, as many of you are aware the board has decided to close the pool parking lot at the end of the pool season this year. We will be installing a chain gate that will be clearly visible with a sign stating the lot is closed. As bond holders, we all share the liability associated with anything that happens on the pool grounds, which includes the parking lot. I know many families in the neighborhood have used the pool parking lot for drop off/pick-up and overflow parking over the years for Maplebrook Elementary School, however, as pool owners, we have absorbed the costs associated with the maintenance and repair of the lot and increased liability risk as the lot is used by many non-members. The board has addressed concerns raised about the use of the lot during the winter months, a time when the pool is closed. We feel that by closing off the lot during this time will protect the interests of all our bond holders and help to reduce our liability risk as owners, a decision we feel is in all of our best interests.

With everything going on in our lives during this busy time of year, please rest assured that you will be able to come to your pool and sit back, relax & enjoy the summer. # Maplebrook Swim Lessons

Swim lessons are a great opportunity for kids to learn swimming and improve basic swimming skills. Member sign-up is on Thursday, June 16th and non-member sign-up is on Friday, June 17th. The lessons start the following week and go for two weeks. There is a week off and then lessons start up again. There are three sessions. The dates are as follows:

The 30 minute lesson times each day start at: 10:30, 11:05, and 11:40.

The fee for members is \$30/session. The fee for non-members is \$50/session.

The week off in between sessions is used for registration as well as make-ups for any lessons lost due to bad weather. The appropriate swim lesson level may be reviewed with the staff during registration.

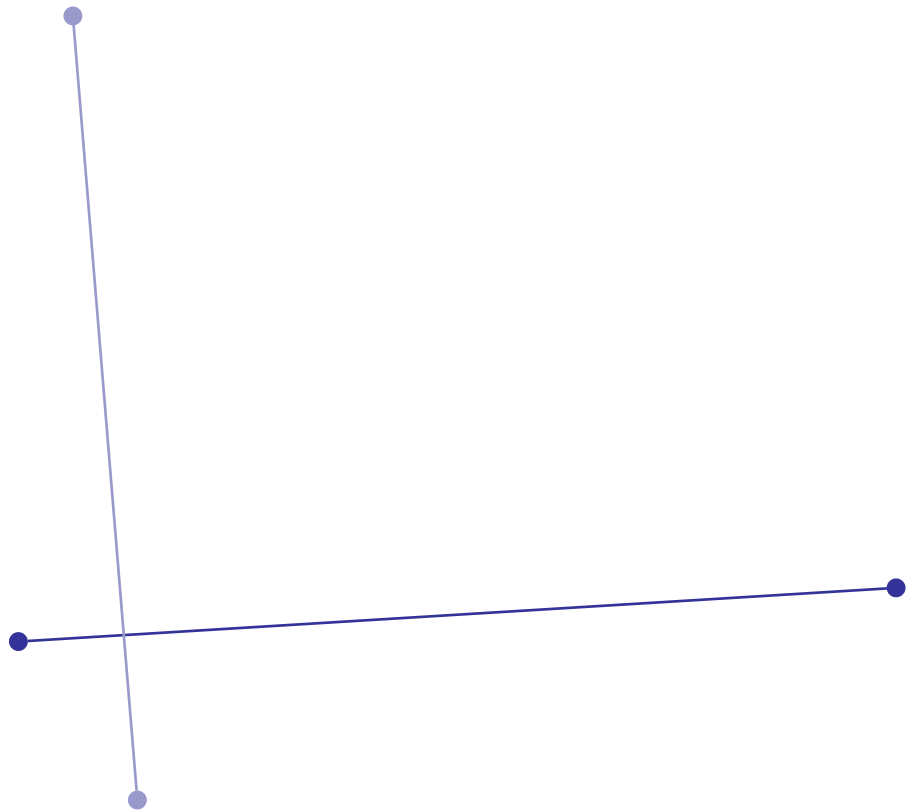
